Pet Food Safety

A Senate inquiry on the *Regulatory approaches to ensure the safety of pet food* released its findings in October 2018. A pet food review Working Group was established in November 2018 at the request of the then Minister for Agriculture and Water Resources the Hon. David Littleproud MP following a number of pet food safety incidents. The Working Group was tasked with reviewing the recommendations of the senate inquiry and the current regulatory system governing pet food and to consider options to manage the health and safety of pet food in Australia.
