Re: Lonsdale v RCVS – Challenge to the validity of the 2017 Council Election (“the Election”)

Thank you for your 11 September 2017 email message and attachments updating me on emails previously not received by me.

I note that Ms Acaster and Professor Wood make mention of their involvement or otherwise with the receipt of junk pet-food funds at their respective universities.

In case my previous submissions have been misunderstood, I wish to emphasise that I consider the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons to be a corrupt body and that the British veterinary schools are also corrupt in their general endorsement and promotion of junk pet-food for pets.

Without doubt pets forced to consume such junk suffer from suboptimal health progressing to sickness and in many cases premature death. The cruelty so arising is a criminal offence.

Insofar as Councillors of the RCVS and staff of veterinary schools support or recommend that trusting petowners should feed junk food to their pets they are, in my view, engaged in fraudulent conduct.

Insofar as Councillors of the RCVS and veterinary school staff support or recommend or turn a blind eye to the brainwashing of students with junk pet-food propaganda they are also engaged in fraudulent conduct.

My challenge to the validity of the 2017 election centres on my belief that the RCVS employed undue influence so as to favour its junk pet-food supporters and friends in the RCVS, the UK veterinary schools and associations.

Since Professors Hammond and Wood and Ms Acaster have a stake in and vested interest in the activities of the RCVS and UK veterinary schools, then I believe that they should recuse themselves from the Challenge Committee.
